**PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS ON BACK**

## **Program One (Saturday Skills League & Clinic) – Grades 3 – 6**

**Program I Purpose:** This program is designed for skill development and introduction to game situations. This level provides a fun level of learning the game. The purpose of this program is to start to introduce competitive play with less focus on winning. Individual development is emphasized. This level will allow the boys to play games with teams from their own community. This program will allow boys with *different skill levels* to compete on the same team, allowing the learning experiences this format provides.

Program I for grades 3-6 will run from October through the first week of December, held on Saturday mornings at Emanuel Lutheran School. There will be 1- 2 practices a week for each team. ***This program is open to both public and parochial school boys, as well as those boys who are home schooled.***

**\*Boys in 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Grade** will play on a combined team league.

**\*Boys in 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Grade** will play on a combined team league.

## **Program Two (Traveling Tournament Teams)– Grades 3-8:**

**Program II Purpose:** This program is designed to provide competitive play for those boys who want to compete at a higher level. This program will allow boys with *similar skills* to compete on the same team, allowing the learning experiences this format provides. This level will allow us to be competitive with other schools' top teams. Teams will play competitively in weekend tournaments in and around Northeast Wisconsin. There will be 1- 2 practices a week for each team.

**Team Make up:** 7-8 players on a team. Goal is to have more teams with fewer players to allow for more playing time. Additional coaches will need to be secured to reach our goal.

\*3<sup>rd</sup> thru 4<sup>th</sup> grade: Teams will be divided evenly

\*5<sup>th</sup> thru 8<sup>th</sup> grade: Teams will be divided by best 7-8 players and then the next best 7-8 players and so on.

**Length of season-** Starts January runs through March. Season may extend to April depending on grade level State tournament (5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade). The 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade teams will start after their Middle School season. Practice for 3<sup>rd</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> may start in December.

Recommended tournament entries by grade, including our own:

3<sup>rd</sup> grade: 2-3 tournaments

5<sup>th</sup> grade: 4-5 tournaments

7<sup>th</sup> grade: 5-6 tournaments

4<sup>th</sup> grade: 3-4 tournaments

6<sup>th</sup> grade: 5-6 tournaments

8<sup>th</sup> grade: 6-7 tournaments
